What is "MAC" ?

The Muskie Anglers Circuit, LLC (MAC) was formed to:

1. Provide a national competitive arena and media platform to showcase the abilities and personalities of the sport's most skilled competitive muskie anglers.
2. Promote muskie angling and conservation and provide educational opportunities for current and future generations of anglers.
3. Showcase products and services that support the sport of muskie fishing.



Entry Details

Entry fee \$750 per team per event plus a \$35 membership fee per year per angler to join. A team may enter all four events with a deposit of \$800 plus \$70 for two memberships with the balance of \$550 due thirty days prior to each event.

Tournament Format

MAC Tournaments are CPR (Catch, Photo, and Immediate Release). The CPR tournament system has been effectively tested in walleye, bass and muskie events over the past several years. Fish are measured using MAC-supplied measuring boards and photographed by MAC contestants prior to release. No fish will be transported for verification in MAC events. MAC judges verify fish length via photography at the virtual weigh-in site prior to each day's stage show.
